WHAT MAKES US 'GREEN'

Our 18th century listed barn and outbuildings were recently converted using energy efficient and sustainable methods into a flexible meeting area, as well as light and spacious modern offices. This **groundbreaking project** successfully demonstrates how state of the art environmental technologies can fit with traditional construction methods and materials, to not only preserve but also to breathe new life into once run-down historic buildings.

Just some of the environmentally friendly methods the conversion incorporated:

Re-used woodwork - solid oak wooden flooring - lights and occupant sensors - underfloor heating - re-using bricks and tiles - sheep's wool insulation - 'evacuated tube' type solar panels - reclaimed concrete flags and eco paints.

We also **harvest rainwater** via gutters which channel it via filters and stored in an underground tank and used for flushing toilets, and our resident bat population is protected with a special **Bat Attic** with the inclusion of designated roof spaces and entry/exit tiles.
